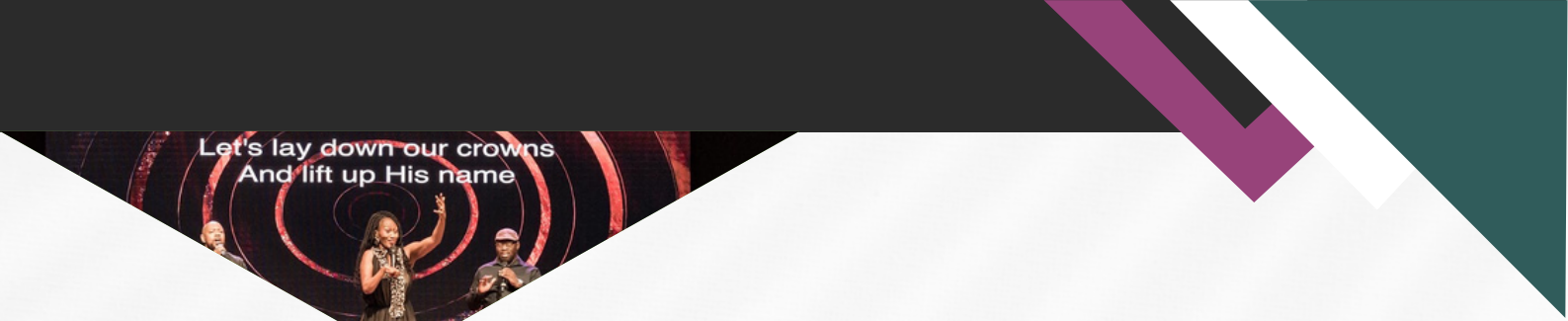

Education Task Force

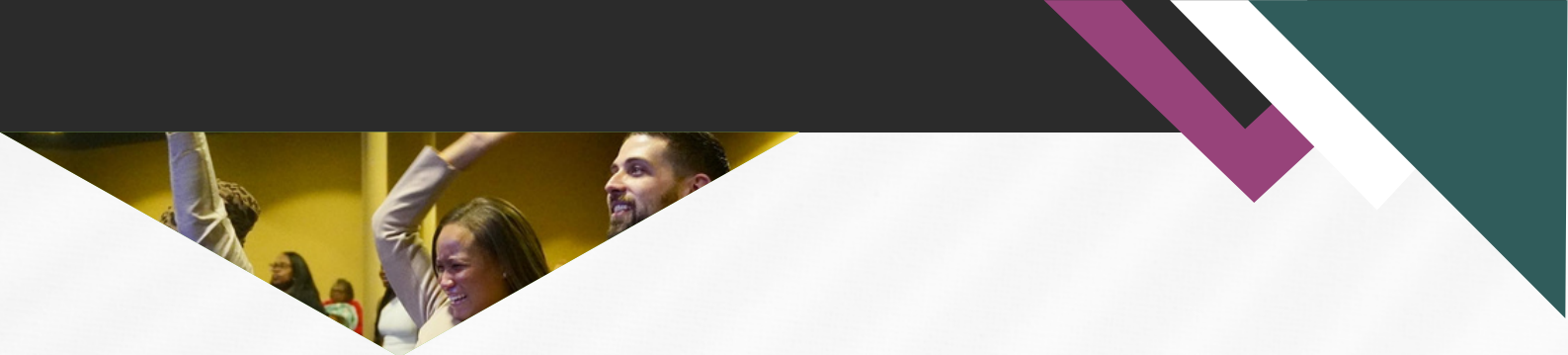

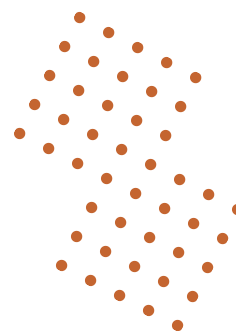
